- ▶ 10 - Don't fear, because I am with you; don't be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will surely help you; I will hold you with my righteous strong hand

Psalm 23:4

- ▶ 4 - Even when I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no danger because you are with me. Your rod and your staff - they protect me.

Hebrews 13:5

- ▶ 5 - Your way of life should be free from the love of money, and you should be content with what you have. After all, he has said, I will never leave you or abandon you.

My Thoughts about It All
